Remarks/Market Observations:		<p>The following observations were gathered during the actual price monitoring activities this week (February 3-7, 2020):</p> <p>*A major increase in the supply of local Galunggong (<i>Decapterus spp.</i>) at the Navotas Fish Port as a result of the lifting of the Closed Fishing Season (CFS) in the Northern Palawan last 31 January 2020. However, most of the available local Galunggong are small-sized.</p> <p>*Other species of marine fishes remain low due to the low volume of catch caused by:</p> <p>(a) the cold weather brought by the Northeast wind "Hanging Amihan," wherein marine fishes normally stay at the bottom of the ocean, and</p> <p>(b) the implementation of Closed Fishing Season (CFS) for other marine fishes such as <i>Sardinella spp.</i> and <i>Rastrelliger spp.</i> in some major fishing grounds in the country.</p> <p>* A large supply of frozen/imported commodities are available at the Navotas Fish Port, majority of which are Squid, Salmon Head, and Galunggong.</p> <p>*The supply of Tilapia at the Navotas Fish Port increased this week as compared to last week, as a result of the increase in supply from Batangas.</p> <p>*The supply of Bangus remain stable. Some brokers/traders decreased their selling price due to the lower demand brought by the increase in the local Galunggong supply.</p>
