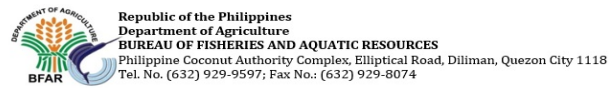

Remarks/Market Observations:	<p>The following observations were gathered during the actual price monitoring activities this week (February 10-14, 2020):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *A large supply of local Galunggong (<i>Decapterus spp.</i>) are available at the Navotas Fish Port this week-- majority of which are small-sized, with a few medium to large-sized. *The supply of other marine fishes, except local Galunggong, remain low due to the low volume of catch caused by: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) the cold weather brought by the Northeast wind "Hanging Amihan," wherein marine fishes normally stay at the bottom of the ocean, (b) the occurrence of full moon last February 9, 2020, the bright moonlight causing the marine fishes to scatter making them difficult to catch, and (c) the implementation of Closed Fishing Season (CFS) for other marine fishes such as <i>Sardinella spp.</i> and <i>Rastrelliger spp.</i> in some major fishing grounds in the country. *The volume of frozen/imported commodities at the fish port remain high despite the availability of local Galunggong. Majority of which are Squid, Salmon Head, and Galunggong. *The supply of Tilapia at the Navotas Fish Port is stable this week due to the increase in the supply from Batangas. However, the farmgate and the wholesale price of the commodity remain high. *The Bangus supply remain stable due to the sufficient volume from Bulacan, Rizal, and Pangasinan. However, there is still no supply of Bangus Batangas observed at the market. *Some brokers/traders decreased their selling price for Bangus and Tilapia due to the lower demand as a result of the increase in the supply of local Galunggong. *The three-month fishing ban for Sardines, Herrings (<i>Sardinella spp.</i>), and Mackerels (<i>Rastrelliger spp.</i>) in some parts of the Visayan Sea (per Fisheries Administrative Order No. 167-3 Series of 2013), is set to end on the 15th day February of 2020.
