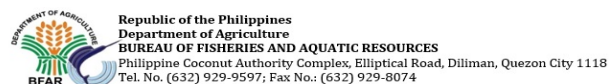

Remarks/Market Observations:		<p>The following observations were gathered during the actual price monitoring activities this week (February 17-21, 2020):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *The supply of marine fishes, excluding local Galunggong (<i>Decapterus spp.</i>), remain low this week. Majority of the available marine fishes are <i>Auxis spp.</i>, <i>Rastrilliger spp.</i>, <i>Decapterus spp.</i>, <i>Selar spp.</i> *The supply of marine fishes continue to be affected by the cold weather, which cause the marine fishes to stay at the bottom of the ocean resulting to a low volume of catch. *A large supply of local Galunggong were observed during the actual price monitoring this week--majority of which are small-sized, with a few medium-sized. *The three-month fishing ban for Sardines, Herrings (<i>Sardinella spp.</i>), and Mackerels (<i>Rastrilliger spp.</i>) in some parts of the Visayan Sea (per Fisheries Administrative Order No. 167-3 Series of 2013) ended last 15 February 2020. The supply of marine fishes is expected to increase in the coming days. *Abundant supply of frozen/imported commodities are still available at the Navotas Fish Port despite the availability of local Galunggong. Majority of which are Squid, Salmon Head, and Galunggong. *The price and supply of Tilapia remain stable this week. However, the farmgate and the wholesale price remain high. *The Bangus supply remain stable due to the sufficient volume from Bulacan, Rizal, and Pangasinan. However, there is still no supply of Bangus Batangas observed at the market. *There were feedback that some brokers/traders decreased their selling price of Bangus and Tilapia due to the low demand from buying public (i.e., <i>matumal ang bentahan</i>), this may be attributed to the increase in the supply of local Galunggong.
