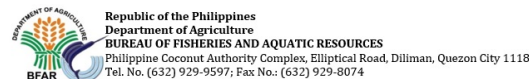

Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered during the actual price monitoring activities this week (March 29 to April 4, 2020):

- *Large volumes of small to medium-sized Local Galunggong was reported at the Navotas Fish Port this week. Supply of imported Galunggong decreased due to the abundant supply of its local variant.
- *The supply for marine fishes like local GG, Tulingan, Dalagang Bukid Bilog, Tahong and Pusit Kalawang were abundant this week.
- *Some of the traders and buyers cannot penetrate the Navotas Fish Port due to lack of IDs from PFDA relative to "No ID, No Entry Policy".
- *These are the precautionary measures implemented by the management to avoid COVID-19: (a) Restriction of ID issuances; (b) Shifting in trading hours to 4:00PM to 1:00AM from 7:00PM to 3:00AM; and (c) "No ID, No Entry Policy".
- *There is a lesser number of vendors observed present in the market.
- *Also, the number of buyers became low due to the strict implementation of Enhanced Community Quarantine and fear of acquiring the Virus(COVID-19) in the market.
