Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from this week's price monitoring activity (7 April 2020):

- The price of Bangus and Tilapia remain stable due to the sufficient supply.
- Large volumes of small to large-sized Galunggong (*Decapterus spp.*) were observed at Navotas Fish Port.
- Increment in price from previous monitoring data may be attributed to the observance of Lenten Season (Holy Week) where fishery commodities are preferred over meat products.
- On April 7, 2020, the Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) in Luzon was extended until April 30 from the initial ending date of April 12 in an effort to curb the spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19).
- The Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) continue the strict implementation of the following precautionary measures as stated in the 3 April 2020 report:
 - "No ID, No Entry";
 - Restriction of ID issuance; and
 - Shift in trading hours [4:00 PM to 1:00 AM (during the ECQ) from 7:00 PM to 3:00 AM (before the ECQ)]
