Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered during the actual price monitoring activities this week (May 3-9, 2020):

- *The supply and demand for Tilapia remain stable this week. Bangus, on the other hand, had a price increase as most of the unloaded volume at the fish port are 2-3 pcs/kg, which is considered as medium to large-sized.
- *Large volume of small-sized Local Galunggong Babae and other fresh marine commodities are unloaded at the fish port. Limited supplies of medium-sized Local Galunggong Lalaki are available as only one source unloaded in the market.
- *Navotas City will be placed under Extreme Enhanced Community Quarantine (EECQ) due to the increasing COVID-19 cases in the city. The Navotas Fish Port Complex Markets 1-5 was closed on May 9 for a complete market disinfection.
- *There continues to be ample supplies of imported fishery commodities at the fish port.
- *The following preventive management measures for buyers and workers in NFPC are continuously being implemented by PFDA:
 1. Wearing of face mask, white shirt, and white rain boots;
 2. Showing of NFPC-issued ID card upon entry;
 3. Checking of temperature (thermal scanning);
 4. Washing of hands in the designated handwash area;
 5. Disinfection of boots in the three-stage footbath; and
 6. Strict maintaining of social distancing.
