Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered during this week's actual price monitoring activities (May 10-16):

- There continues to be sufficient supplies of Bangus and Tilapia. The higher price of Bangus may be attributed to the number of pieces (2-3 pcs/kg) which is medium to large-sized.
- Large volumes of small-sized galungong babae and fresh marine commodities were unloaded at the market. Abundant supplies of imported commodities are also available. However, there are no medium-sized Bangus from Bulacan and Laguna.
- Navotas Fish Port was closed from May 9 (2:00PM) to May 10 (4:00PM) for a full sanitation and disinfection. Effective 16 May 2020, Navotas City will shift to Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) from being under Extreme ECQ.
- The Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) continues the strict implementation of the precautionary management measures stated in previous reports.
