**Remarks/Market Observations:**

**The following observations were gathered during the actual price monitoring activities this week ( May 17-23, 2020):**

- \*Prices of Tilapia (from Batangas & Bulacan) and Bangus (from Zambales) are stable as a result of the low demand from customers. Bangus from Dagupan are sold at a higher price due to its premium quality.
- \*Large volumes of Local Galunggong (from Palawan) and mixed fishery commodities such as Tulingan, Matambaka and Tamban are unloaded at the Fish Port this week.
- \*Imported commodities are still available at the Navotas Fish Port. However, there abundant supply of fresh commodities contributed in the decrease in the price of imported galunggong in the market.
- \*The following preventive management measures for buyers and workers are continuously being implemented in NFPC:
  1. Wearing of face mask, white shirt, and white rain boots;
  2. Showing of NFPC-issued ID card upon entry;
  3. Checking of temperature (thermal scanning);
  4. Washing of hands in the designated handwash area;
  5. Disinfection of boots in the three-stage footbath; and
  6. Strict maintaining of social distancing.
- \*Market schedules clustered per barangay is also being implemented at the Navotas Fish Port as part of the measures under Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ) in Navotas City to avoid congestion and spreading of the virus.
