Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators this week:

- Bangus, Tilapia, and Local Galunggong are found to have adequate volumes among the monitored retail markets relative to the current low demand.
- Medium-sized Imported Galunggong was also observed this week but only at Mega-Q Market. However, larger variants of the commodity was also noted at Farmers Market.
- Top fishery commodities in the ten (10) monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local Galunggong - Navotas & Malabon Fish Ports
- Buyers in the monitored markets remain few as the public continue to take precaution against COVID-19 amid the rapidly increasing number of positive cases in Metro Manila. In response, vendors are either opting to sell lesser volumes or not open their fish stalls at all.
- Precautionary safety measures aligned to MECQ are continuously observed in the monitored retail markets. Effective 19 August 2020, NCR and other areas returned to General Community Quarantine or GCQ. - Per DA AC No. 10, updated Suggested Retail Prices (SRP) for medium-sized Bangus is at Php169.00/kg, medium-sized Tilapia at Php120.00/kg, Local Galunggong (no size indicate) at Php140.00/kg, and medium-sized Imported Galunggong at Php180.00/kg.
- Based on the price monitoring activities, the following markets were observed to have vendors who are not compliant with the SRPs:
 - Tilapia - Kamuning Market
 - Local Galunggong - all monitored retail markets
- Data gathering at the nine (9) retail markets is conducted through phone calls or SMS in coordination with market masters and administrators, vendors, and stall holders in view of the Bureau's suspension of physical monitoring activities since July 21, 2020. Physical monitoring will resume once safety of enumerators in the monitored wet markets is ascertained.
