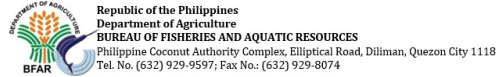

Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors:

- Among the monitored retail markets, Bangus, Tilapia, and Local Galunggong continue to be sufficient in volumes to cater to the low demand. However, marine commodities still have relatively low availability in the markets amid the hampered fishing operations brought about by the lean fishing season and rainy weather condition. Further, "natural na bentahan" continues to be observed due to the continuously increasing number of COVID-19 cases in Metro Manila, except at Farmers and Mega-Q Markets where relatively higher foot traffic was noted. For Imported Galunggong, no medium size variants were observed as only large-sized were available at Mega-Q and Farmers Markets.
- Following are the main source areas of the top fishery commodities:
 Commodity Retail (10 monitored markets)
 Bangus Bulacan
 Tilapia Batangas
 Local Galunggong Navotas & Malabon Fish Ports
- To safeguard the vendors and buyers against COVID-19, market administrators continue to implement precautionary measures such as wearing of face masks and face shields, and mandatory temperature checks. At Commonwealth and Tandang Sora Markets, limited market hours of 5:00AM - 6:00PM is also strictly implemented. Social distancing, however, is no longer strictly implemented in the markets. Weekly disinfection is also done in selected markets.
- Per DA MC No. 10, updated Suggested Retail Prices (SRP) for medium-sized Bangus is at Php160.00/kg, medium-sized Tilapia at Php120.00/kg, Local Galunggong (no size indicate) at Php140.00/kg, and medium-sized Imported Galunggong at Php180.00/kg.
- Based on the price monitoring activities, the following markets were observed to have vendors who are not compliant with the SRPs:
 a. Tilapia Medium - Kamuning Market
 b. Local Galunggong - Kamuning, Galas, Trabajo, Quinta, Munoz, Tandang Sora, Mega-Q Commonwealth and Farmers Markets
- Data gathering at the nine (9) retail markets is conducted through phone calls or SMS in coordination with market masters and administrators, vendors, and stall holders in view of the Bureau's suspension of physical monitoring activities since July 21, 2020. Physical monitoring will resume once safety of enumerators in the monitored wet markets is ascertained.
