**Remarks/Market Observations:**

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors:

- At Navotas Fish Port Markets 1-2, supplies of fresh marine commodities are unstable due to the hampered fishing operations brought about by the lean fishing season and rainy weather condition. Meanwhile, aquacultured commodities continue to be abundant in supplies.
- There is high supply of Imported Galunggong, being a substitute commodity for fresh commodities at Navotas Fish Port this week as the unloaded volume of fresh marine commodities continue to low.
- Low demand of fishery commodities was still observed at Navotas Fish Port.
- Top fishery commodities are sourced mainly from the following areas:  
 Commodity      Wholesale (Navotas Fish Port)  
 Bangus              Pangasinan  
 Tilapia              Batangas  
 Local Galunggong      Palawan
- In order to ensure the safety of vendors and buyers, Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) continues the implementation of precautionary management measures at Navotas Fish Port Complex.
- Data gathering at the nine (9) retail markets is conducted through phone calls or SMS in coordination with market masters and administrators, vendors, and stall holders in view of the Bureau's suspension of physical monitoring activities since July 21, 2020. Physical monitoring will resume once safety of enumerators in the monitored wet markets is ascertained.
