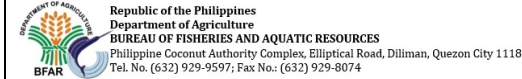

**Remarks/Market Observations:**  
 The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors:  
 1. Bangus and Tilapia continue to have adequate supplies in the monitored retail and wholesale markets. Local Galunggong, however, continues to have limited volumes throughout all monitored markets amid the lean fishing season; hence, the relatively high retail price of the commodity. Medium-sized Imported Galunggong continues to have low availability and was observed at Mega-Q, Balintawak, and Muñoz Markets only.  
 2. Major source areas of the top fishery commodities are the following:  
 Commodity Retail (10 monitored markets)  
 Bangus Bulacan  
 Tilapia Batangas  
 Local Galunggong Malabon & Navotas Fish Ports  
 3. Minimal number of consumers are observed in most monitored markets, urging vendors to limit the volume of fish supplies for selling avoid loss of profit and spoilage. Farmers Market, being a primary market, has relatively high number of buyers on September 1.  
 4. In response to the increasing COVID-19 cases, precautionary safety measures (e.g., wearing of face masks and face shields, mandatory temperature checks, limiting of buyers entering the markets, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection) are continuously being implemented in the markets. Social distancing, however, is not being strictly observed among all monitored markets. Retail operations at Balintawak Market have resumed on August 29 (Saturday) after its four-month suspension beginning April 11.  
 4. Per DA AC No. 10, updated Suggested Retail Prices (SRP) for medium-sized Bangus is at Php169.00/kg, medium-sized Tilapia at Php120.00/kg, Local Galunggong (no size indicate) at Php140.00/kg, and medium-sized Imported Galunggong at Php180.00/kg.  
 Biased on the price monitoring activities, the following markets were observed to have vendors who are not compliant with the SRPs:  
 a. Tilapia Medium - Kamuning Market  
 b. Local Galunggong - Kamuning, Galas, Trabajo, Quinta, Muñoz, Tandang Sora, Mega-Q, Commonwealth Farmers, and Balintawak Markets  
 5. Data gathering at the nine (9) retail markets is conducted through phone calls or SMS in coordination with market masters and administrators, vendors, and stall holders in view of the Bureau's suspension of physical monitoring activities since July 21, 2020. Physical monitoring will resume once safety of enumerators in the monitored wet markets is ascertained.
