The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors:

1. Still, Bangus and Tilapia remain adequate in volume in the monitored retail markets relative to the low demand from consumers. Meanwhile, Local Galunggong continues to have minimal availability in the monitored markets, amid the rain fishing season and rainy weather condition. The low availability at Navotas Fish Port also urged retailers to find alternative sources of the commodity such as Lucena, Quezon. Imported Galunggong was observed to have higher demand among monitored markets due to the low supply of its local variant.
2. Following are the major source areas of the top fishery commodities:

3. Low influx of buyers and fewer number of operational fish stalls are observed in the monitored retail markets as vendors and consumers continue to take precaution against COVID-19, alongside the rainy weather condition. Higher foot traffic was observed this week during market hours (morning). As a result, some vendors opted to limit their volume of fish to sell out in a day to avoid spoilage and loss of profit while some only open their fish stalls on weekends.
4. Precautionary safety measures relative to COVID-19 prevention are still implemented in the monitored-retail markets. Safe physical distancing, however, is not strictly implemented in the markets.
5. Effective August 13, Suggested Retail Prices (SRPs) for top fishery commodities are Php169.00/kg (Bangus), Php120.00/kg (Tilapia), Php140.00/kg (Local Galunggong), and Php180.00/kg (Imported Galunggong). For Tilapia, only Kamuning Market has vendors exceeding the maximum allowable limit of the SRP at Php132.00/kg. However, for Local Galunggong, all markets are non-compliant with and above the maximum allowable limit of Php154.00/kg.
6. Data gathering at the ten (10) retail markets is conducted through phone calls or SMS in coordination with market masters and administrators, vendors, and stall holders in view of the Bureau's suspension of physical monitoring activities since July 21, 2020. Physical monitoring will resume once safety of enumerators in the monitored wet markets is ascertained.
