The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors:

- As the pandemic continues to bring low foot traffic in the monitored markets, supplies of Bangus and Tilapia remain enough to cater to the low demand for fishery commodities. Local Galunggong, however, still has less supplies in the monitored markets as an effect of the lean fishing season and rainy weather condition. Imported Galunggong is still observed in only few markets. Further, vendors in Balintawak and Muñoz prefer to sell the imported variant due to its low wholesale price or "hanggo."
- Vendors at Farmers and Mega-Q noted that the prices of imported galunggong is expected to remain relatively high until the Christmas season.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
Commodity Retail (10 monitored markets)
Bangus Bulacan
Tilapia Batangas
Local Galunggong Malabon Fish Port, Farmers Market
- Due to "matatagal na bentahan," some vendors are continuously looking for strategies to avoid loss of sales such as (a) selling only in the morning where there are more buyers, and (b) limiting volumes of fishery commodities for selling to avoid spoilage. Other vendors are also now offering online orders for delivery, and securing pre-orders from their "suki."
- Safety measures in line with the General Community Quarantine (GCQ) are continuously implemented at the retail markets.
- On Suggested Retail Price (SRP) compliance, only Local Galunggong remains to be sold above the maximum allowable limit (Php154.00/kg) of its set SRP. Bangus, Tilapia, and Imported Galunggong are all sold within their respective SRPs of Php169.00/kg, Php120.00/kg, and Php180.00/kg.
- Data gathering at the ten (10) retail markets is conducted through phone calls or SMS in coordination with market masters and administrators, vendors, and stall holders in view of the Bureau's suspension of physical monitoring activities since July 21, 2020. Physical monitoring will resume once safety of enumerators in the monitored wet markets is ascertained.
