**Remarks/Market Observations:**

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Bangus and Tilapia still has adequate supplies at Navotas Fish Port; however, Local Galunggong continues to have minimal availability due to low volume of catch amid the occurrence of full moon and southwest moonsoon coinciding with the lean season for fishing.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:  
 Commodity    Wholesale (Navotas Fish Port)  
 Bangus            Pangasinan  
 Tilapia            Batangas  
 Local Galunggong    Palawan
- In line with the General Community Quarantine (GCQ) protocols, Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) continues the implementation of precautionary management measures (e.g wearing of face masks and face shields, mandatory temperature checks and hand disinfection) at Navotas Fish Port Complex in order to ensure the safety of vendors and buyers.
- Data gathering at the wholesale market is conducted through phone calls or SMS in coordination with PFDA in view of the Bureau's suspension of physical monitoring activities since July 21, 2020. Physical monitoring will resume once safety of enumerators in the monitored wet markets is ascertained.
