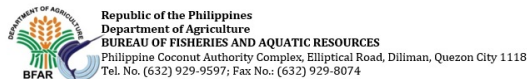

Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors this week:

- Unloading of Local-fresh Galunggong, among other fresh marine commodities, at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) was noted to be lower but still sufficeint this week. For instance, only a total of 875 tubs of medium-sized Local-fresh Galunggong were unloaded on March 30. This may be effects of the Super Full Moon on March 28, which caused bright light that pushes fishes to the bottom of the ocean, making them harder to catch.
- Despite the sufficient availability of its local variant, small volumes of Imported-frozen Galunggong are still available at Navotas Fish Port. However, wholesale price of the imported variant was noted to be unstable and dependent on the availability of fresh marine commodities.
- Aquacultured commodities, especially Tilapia and Bangus, continue to have sufficient availability and stable prices at Navotas Fish Port with varyin prices depending on the size and total volume of unloaded supply.
- Major source areas of the top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are as follows:
 - Bangus - Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local Galunggong - Palawan
- Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) are implementing precautionary safety measures against COVID-19 in line with the implementation of Enhanced Community Quarantine in NCR Plus (inc. Bulacan, Rizal and Laguna) from March 29 to April 4. Among these measures are mandatory wearing of face masks, face shields, white shirt, and white boots; and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection.
