Remarks/Market Observations:	<p>The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of March:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Supplies of small to medium-sized Local-fresh Galunggong were observed with abundant volumes at the monitored retail markets this month. Relative to this, lower volumes of Imported-frozen Galunggong were noted at the monitored retail markets. Still, vendors penchant for the local variant results from the consumers' preference for the local variant.</li> <li>Alumahan continue to have unstable and limited supply at the monitored retail markets. Most of the supply are large-sized sourced from Malabon Fish Port.</li> <li>Aquacultured commodities like Bangus and Tilapia were noted to have ample supplies in the monitored retail markets, resulting to the stable prevailing prices.</li> <li>Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets were sourced mainly from the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bangus - Bulacan</li> <li>Tilapia - Batangas</li> <li>Local-fresh Galunggong - Malabon Fish Port (Lucena, Quezon) &amp; Navotas Fish Port (Palawan)</li> <li>Imported-frozen Galunggong - Navotas Fish Port</li> <li>Alumahan - Malabon Fish Port</li> </ol> </li> </ol>
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Low demand for fishery commodities remain apparent in most markets. With this, vendors are adapting ways to avoid loss of profit and to ensure that all fish displays are sold out by the end of the day. Among these measures are: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Limiting their fishery commodities for selling;</li> <li>Sell their unsold stocks at a lower price; and</li> <li>Opening only on selected days where there is higher influx of buyers such as during weekends.</li> </ol> </li> <li>Market administrators are still ensuring the stringent implementation of precautionary measures against COVID-19 in accordance with ECQ (April 1-11) and MECQ (April 12-30) (eg, wearing of face mask and face shields, mandatory temperature checks, and observance of physical distancing, among others) in the markets as precaution against COVID-19.</li> <li>No physical price monitoring activity was conducted at Pasay Public Market and Navotas Fish Port Markets 3-5 this week due the strict lockdown implemented by their respective LGUs. Meanwhile, in the markets monitored by BFAR CO, data gathering is done via text and call and covers only the Top 4 Commodities (Bangus, Tilapia, Local-fresh &amp; Imported-frozen Galunggong, Alumahan). Resumption of physical price monitoring activities in the monitored markets will be subject to risk assessment with the top management.</li> </ol>
