**Remarks/Market Observations:**

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of February:

- Fresh marine commodities, such as Local-fresh Galunggong and Alumahan, continues to have unpredictable and limited unloadings at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale). The limited availability of fresh marine commodities may be attributed to Tropical Storm Auring, which had its landfall on Feb. 21, as well as the cold weather condition brought by the Northeast Moonsoon or *Hanging Amihan*, which drives fish to the bottom of the ocean, making them harder to catch.
- In addition, majority of the fresh marine commodities (i.e., Local-fresh Galunggong, Tunsoy, Gulyasan) unloaded at Navotas Fish Port were small-sized. This may have been caused by the recent lifting of Closed Fishing Season (CFS) in Northeastern Palawan (Jan. 31) and in Visayan Sea (Feb. 15).
- Meanwhile, aquaculture commodities, particularly Bangus and Tilapia, were noted to have sufficient availability this month, resulting to the steady wholesale prices at the fish port.
- Imported-frozen Galunggong was available at Navotas Fish Port this month as an alternative commodity to its local variant. However, it was noted that its wholesale prices was volatile and highly dependent on the unloaded volume and species of fresh marine commodities.
- Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas:
  - Bangus - Pangasinan
  - Tilapia - Batangas
  - Imported Galunggong - China, Vietnam
- Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) at Navotas Fish Port continues to implement precautionary safety measures against COVID-19. These measures include wearing of face masks and face shields, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection.
