Tilapia =Batangas 3.1 Galunggong =Quezon Province, Tawi-tawi, Zambales, Bicol 3.2 Imported Galunggong = China, Vietnam</p> <p>*The price of marine fish is relatively high at this time due the limited supply that may be attributed to the cold weather for which the catch is usually low and difficult because fish tend to stay at the bottom o the ocean. *DA-BFAR has lifted the closed season for Galunggong in Northeastern Palawan, with resumption of commercial fishing activities starting Feb. 1, 2019. (Source: Press Release by BFAR RFO-4B, dated 31 Jan. 2019) *As per the feedback of enumerators, most of the Galunggong sold at the wholesale market are imported and are mostly from China and Vietnam. *A fish kill incident happened on the Taal Lake for Bangus and Tilapia on the last week of this month, but despite the incident happened the wholesale prices of Bangus and Tilapia remained at Php110/kg and Php 80/kg, respectively. *Relative to BFAR's public statement that some areas in the Philippines are found positive from paralytic shellfish poison that is beyond regular limit (Shellfish Bulletin No. 1, S. 2019), it was noted by some vendors that the price of tahong in the market was not directly affected.</p>
