Remarks/Market Observations:	<p>*Major Source Areas of Top 3 commodities; 1. Bangus = Laguna, Bulacan, Rizal, Pampanga, Batangas, Pangasinan, and Navotas, Malabon, & Farmers Markets 2. Tilapia = Batangas, Bulacan, Pampanga, and Navotas, Malabon, & Farmers Markets 3. Galunggong = Zambales, Quezon Province, Palawan, and Navotas, Malabon, & Farmers Markets</p> <p>*The prevailing retail price of medium-sized Bangus, Tilapia, and local Galunggong are currently low this month at Php140.00/kg & Php160.00/kg, Php100.00/kg, and Php160.00/kg, respectively. Based on the data gathered, this might still be attributed to the abundant supply of the three commodities alongside the low demand from customers (i.e., "matumal ang bentahan"). It was also observed that some vendors are selling their fish products at a very low price to avoid spoilage and just to get back their capital. *It was derived from market interviews that some markets vendors in NCR are limiting their supply of fishery commodities as a response to the low demand from the buying public. *It was observed during the 3rd week of this month that the supply of marine fishes (including Galunggong) decreased due to the occurrence of full moon where the bright light causes marine fishes to scatter, making them more difficult to catch. Despite the decrease in the supply of local Galunggong, the commodity's prevailing price remained stable. *It was observed in some of monitored markets that the price of live Tilapia is higher by Php20.00/kg as compared to fresh dead Tilapia. *Based on team's actual price monitoring during the 1st and 2nd week (May 4-17) of this month, there is an abundance of supply of Tulingan (<i>Auxis rochei</i>) in majority of the monitored markets in NCR. *The supply of Bangus, Tilapia and Galunggong in majority of the monitored markets are being sold in mixed sizes. *On the 1st week of this month (May 6-10), the supply of some high value marine fishes (e.g., Lapu-lapu and Maya) and some seaweeds (e.g., Lato and Guso) are lesser in majority of the monitored markets in NCR. *No price monitoring activity conducted at Navotas Fish Port (Markets 3, 4, and 5) on the first week and Farmers & Mega Q market on the second week of this month due to unavailability of enumerator.</p>
