<b>Remarks/Market Observations:</b>			<p><b>The following observations were gathered during the actual price monitoring activities at the Navotas Fish Port for the month of June:</b></p> <p>*Bangus and Tilapia supplies at the fish port were sufficient throughout the month, wherein majority of the available bangus are medium to large-sized (2-3 pcs/kg) from Pangasinan. Batangas for tilapia. Bangus from Pangasinan are sold at a higher price due to its premium quality (in terms of size and taste).</p> <p>*Following are the dominant source areas of bangus, tilapia, and local galunggong at the Navotas Fish Port:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bangus - Pangasinan</li> <li>Tilapia - Batangas</li> <li>Local Galunggong - Palawan</li> </ol> <p>*During the first week of May, large volumes of fresh marine commodities such as local galunggong were unloaded at the Navotas Fish Port. However, the onset of Typhoon Ambo on the second week of the month caused lower availability of marine commodities. The supply and variety of fishery commodities then returned on the third week upon resumption of fishing and trading operations. However, available fresh commodities on the third week were noted to be of lower quality.</p> <p>*Imported fish commodities including but not limited to Galunggong, Pusit, Salmon, and Chub Mackerel were also being traded at the Navotas Fish Port. However, supplies of imported galunggong are noted to be either brought to provinces or processed for smoked galunggong or "tinapa."</p> <p>*Fish kill in Anda and Bolinao, Pangasinan affected Php21.9 million worth of fingerlings and harvestable Bangus (The Philippine Star, 23 May 2020), resulting to an increase in the selling price of Bangus from Pangasinan. However, sufficient supplies of Bangus coming from various sources caused no change in the prevailing wholesale price of the commodity.</p> <p>*According to BFAR-RFO 1, bangus farmed in Pangasinan are only available in large sizes (2pcs/kg). However, some vendors in the monitored wet markets declare their supply of medium-sized bangus (3pcs/kg) to be sourced from Pangasinan in order to sell the commodity at premium price.</p> <p>*Demand for fishery commodities at the Navotas Fish Port continue to be low as the public continue to take precaution against the COVID-19 pandemic.</p> <p>*Navotas Fish Port shifted to Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ) beginning 16 May 2020 as a result of the increasing COVID-19 cases in the city. Market schedules are also clustered per barangay in order to avoid congestion and further spread of the virus.</p> <p>*The Navotas Fish Port Complex Markets 1-5 were closed on 9 May 2020 for a complete market disinfection.</p> <p>*There continues to be low influx of buyers at the Navotas Fish Port.</p> <p>*The Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) continues the strict implementation of the following precautionary management measures:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Wearing of face mask, white shirt, and white rain boots;</li> <li>Showing of NFPC-issued ID card upon entry;</li> <li>Checking of temperature (thermal scanning);</li> <li>Washing of hands in the designated handwash area;</li> <li>Disinfection of boots in the three-stage footbath; and</li> <li>Strict compliance to social distancing policy.</li> </ol>
