Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of September:

- Relative to the consistently low demand for fishery commodities, volumes of Bangus and Tilapia remain sufficient at Navotas Fish Port. Meanwhile, Local Galunggong continues to have price fluctuations at Navotas Fish Port as volume of unloadings remain unstable amid (a) occurrence of full moon, (b) southwest monsoon causing unfavorable weather condition or heavy rainfalls, and (c) hampered fishing operations brought about by the lean fishing season. More Imported Galunggong were noted at the wholesale market amid the increase in demand as the imported commodity is treated as a substitute commodity for fresh commodities, which are low in availability. This also resulted to an increase in the selling price of Imported Galunggong. Other fishery commodities available at Navotas Fish Port are Galunggong "Babae", Tambakol, Sap-Sap, and Dalagang Bukid, among others.
- Following are the dominant source areas of the top fishery commodities:
 Commodity Wholesale (Navotas Fish Port)
 Bangus Pangasinan
 Tilapia Batangas
 Local Galunggong Palawan
- Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) continues the implementation of precautionary management measures at Navotas Fish Port Complex in order to ensure the safety of vendors and buyers. Wearing of face masks and face shields, mandatory temperature checks and hand disinfection, and other precautionary safety measures relative to COVID-19 are among the measures in place at the wholesale market.
- Data gathering at Navotas Fish Port is conducted through phone calls or SMS in coordination with market masters and administrators, vendors, and stall holders in view of the Bureau's suspension of physical monitoring activities since July 21, 2020. Physical monitoring will resume once safety of enumerators in the monitored wet markets are ascertained.
