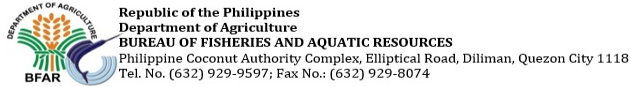

Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnels this week:

- At Navotas Fish Port (wholesale), abundant volumes of fresh marine commodities were recorded. Medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) were sourced mainly from Northern Palawan.
- With the availability of its local-fresh variant, only female variant (*Decapterus russelli*) was available at the fish port this week.
- For Bangus, only smaller sizes from Bulacan were unloaded at Navotas Fish Port. Nonetheless, sufficient volumes of medium-sized Bangus were still available this week sourced from Pangasinan, Laguna, and Batangas. Meanwhile, Tilapia remain stable due to its steady supply and demand.
- Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port Markets 1 & 1 were sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local-fresh galunggong- Northern Palawan
 - Imported galunggong - China
- Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) continues to implement precautionary measures (e.g., wearing of face mask and face shields as well as white boots and shirts, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection) to protect vendors and buyers against COVID-19.
