Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Sufficient volumes of fresh marine commodities like Hipon, Gulyasan, Tulingan, Tambakol, Tamban, Dalagang bukid, Salinyase, Tunsoy, Bisugo, and Pusit were unloaded at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. Moreover, supply of Local-fresh Galunggong increased compared last week. The actual price of Local-fresh Galunggong is Php120.00/kg & Php130.00/kg.
- No Imported-frozen Galunggong "lalaki" were recorded at Navotas Fish Port. Only Imported-frozen Galunggong "Babae" was available.
- The prevailing wholesale prices of Bangus and Tilapia remained the same due to the stable and sufficient supply at Navotas Fish Port. This may be attributed to the stable demand from the buying public.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan, Laguna
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local galunggong- Palawan
 - Imported galunggong - China
- Precautionary measures against COVID-19 (i.e., mandatory wearing of face masks and face shields, as well as white boots and shirts, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection) are continuously implemented by the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) at Navotas Fish Port Complex to safeguard vendors and buyers against COVID-19.
