**Remarks/Market Observations:**

**The following observations were gathered from market personnel:**

- Abundant unloading of fresh marine commodities, especially local-fresh Galunggong (*Decapterus macrosoma*), were observed at the Navotas Fish Port this week. The actual price of Local-fresh Galunggong is Php113.00/kg & Php130.00/kg.
- Still, Imported-frozen Galunggong "lalaki" was not available at Navotas Fish Port as supplies of Local-fresh Galunggong continued to be abundant. Only Imported-frozen Galunggong "Babae" was observed to be available at the fish port.
- No changes were reported in the prevailing wholesale prices of Bangus and Tilapia this week. This may be attributed to the stable and sufficient supply at Navotas Fish Port.
- Other fresh marine commodities like Pusit lumot, Hipon, Gulyasan, Tambakol, Dalagang bukid, Salinyase, Tunsoy, Bisugo, Burot, Balsa and Sapsap were recorded to have abundant volumes unloaded at the fish port this week.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
  - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
  - Tilapia - Batangas
  - Local galunggong- Palawan
  - Imported galunggong - China
- Precautionary measures against COVID-19 (i.e., mandatory wearing of face masks and face shields, as well as white boots and shirts, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection) are continuously implemented by the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) at Navotas Fish Port Complex to safeguard vendors and buyers against COVID-19.
