Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of May:

- Generally unloadings of fresh marine commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) remain sufficient. For medium-sized Local-fresh Galunggong Lalaki (*Decapterus macrossoma*), the prices this month are noted to be at a wide price range due to variations in source areas of unloaded supplies.
- Imported-frozen Galunggong continues to have available supply at the Navotas Fish Port with a monthly prevailing price of Php120.00/kg (*Decapterus macrossoma*) and Php90.00/kg (*Decapterus russelli*) despite the abundance of its local variant.
- Meanwhile, wholesale prices of Bangus and Tilapia remain stable due to its steady supply and demand. Most supplies of Bangus from Pangasinan were reportedly bigger in size at 2-3 pcs/kg.
- Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Laguna, Bulacan, Pangasinan, Batangas
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - local-fresh galunggong - Northern Palawan
 - Imported-frozen Galunggong - China, Vietnam
- As the COVID-19 pandemic remain in place, the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) continues to ensure the implementation of precautionary safety measures (eg., wearing of face masks and face shields as well as white shirt and white boots; and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection) to avoid further spread of the virus at Navotas Fish Port.
