Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Sufficient volumes of fresh marine commodities (i.e., dalagang bukid, betilya, pusit, matambaka, salinyase, tunsoy, burot, tambakol, galunggong) were unloaded at Navotas Fish Port in the early part of the week. Limited volumes of marine commodities were observed at the last part of the week due to the bad weather condition brought by Typhoon "Fabian" last July 21. More specifically, for local-fresh galunggong "lalaki", five (5) markets only (Commonwealth, Tandang Sora, Munoz, Kamuning, Galas Markets) were observed to have displays of the commodity. The actual wholesale price of local-fresh galunggong is at Php170.00/kg-Php200.00/kg.
- Imported-frozen Galunggong "lalaki" were available at Navotas Fish Port as a substitute commodity for local-fresh galunggong. The actual wholesale price of imported-frozen galunggong is at Php120.00/kg.
- No changes in the prevailing wholesale prices of Bangus and Tilapia due to the steady supplies at the Navotas Fish Port.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local galunggong- Palawan
 - Imported galunggong - China
- Precautionary measures against COVID-19 (i.e., mandatory wearing of face masks and face shields, as well as white boots and shirts, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection) are continuously implemented by the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) at Navotas Fish Port Complex to safeguard vendors and buyers against COVID-19.
