**Remarks/Market Observations:**

**The following observations were gathered from market personnel:**

- Generally, limited unloadings of fresh marine commodities were observed at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week, as fishing and trading operations remain hampered by the rainy weather condition brought by *Southwest Monsoon* (Habagat). Relatively, limited availability of medium-sized Local-fresh Galunggong Lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) were noted this week.
- Meanwhile, available supplies of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki were noted at the fishport this week as supplies of its local variant remain affected by the bad weather condition.
- Relative to the limited supplies of fresh marine commodities, the prevailing wholesale prices of aquacultured commodities have minimal changes recorded this week at Php90/kg-140/kg for bangus and Php90/kg for tilapia.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
  - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
  - Tilapia - Batangas
  - Local galunggong- NA
  - Imported galunggong - China
- Precautionary measures (e.g., wearing of face mask and face shields as well as white boots and shirts, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection) are continuously implemented by the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) at Navotas Fish Port Complex to safeguard vendors and buyers against COVID-19.
