**Remarks/Market Observations:**

**The following observations were gathered from market personnel:**

- Limited unloadings of fresh marine commodities were observed at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week, as fishing and trading operations remain hampered by the rainy weather condition brought by *Southwest Monsoon* (Habagat). Relatively, limited availability of medium-sized Local-fresh Galunggong Lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) were noted this week with an actual price of Php150.00- Php180.00/kg source from Palawan.
- Availability of supplies for imported-frozen galunggong lalaki and babae were noted at the Fish Port this week as supplies of its local-fresh variant remain limited.
- For medium sized bangus, prices ranges at Php90.00 - Php145.00/kg this week source from Pangasinan, Bulacan, and Laguna. In addition, larger sizes for bangus Pangasinan were noted this week (2-3pcs/kg).
- Meanwhile, for medium sized tilapia prevailing price was sustained this week at Php90.00/kg as supplies of the commodity remain steady at the Fish Port.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
  - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
  - Tilapia - Batangas
  - Imported galunggong - China
- Precautionary measures (e.g., wearing of face mask and face shields as well as white boots and shirts, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection) are continuously implemented by the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) at Navotas Fish Port Complex to safeguard vendors and buyers against COVID-19.
