Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- At Navotas Fish Port, ample volumes of fresh marine commodities were noted this week. Among the commodities recorded were tambakol, gulyasan, bisugo, lapad, pusit, galunggong, turay and salinyase. Relative to this, sufficient availability of supply for medium-sized Local-fresh Galunggong Lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) was recorded this week with an actual price of Php125.00-Php145.00/kg source from Northern Palawan. Additionally, abundant availability of other variants such as Balsa (*Decapterus macarellus*) and galunggong babae (*Decapterus ruselli*) were also noted at the Fish port.
- In connection with the ample availability of local-fresh variant of galunggong (*Decapterus macrosoma*). Limited supplies of imported-frozen galunggong was recorded this week at the Fish Port.
- There continuous to have sufficient availability of supplies for medium sized bangus this week at the Fish port. Relatively, lower prevailing price was recorded this week at Php100.00/kg. Among the major sources of the commodity are from Pangasinan and Laguna.
- Meanwhile, prevailing price of medium sized tilapia was noted to be in steady level, price at Php90.00 & 100.00/kg source majority from Batangas.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Laguna, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Imported galunggong - China
- Precautionary measures (e.g., wearing of face mask and face shields as well as white boots and shirts, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection) are continuously implemented by the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) at Navotas Fish Port Complex to safeguard vendors and buyers against COVID-19.
