FISHERIES ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER No. 13-1

SUBJECT: Amending Section 2 of Fisheries (Fish and Game) Administrative Order No. 13 of July 1, 1939.

1. Section 2 of Fisheries (Fish and Game) Administrative Order No. 13, s. 1939 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Prohibition. -It shall be unlawful for any person, association, or corporation to kill or catch, or cause to be killed, caught or taken from those waters, purchase, sell, offer or expose for sale, any sexually mature sardines, or herrings, or their larvae, fry or young known as siliñasi or hupoy, during the closed season, from November 15 to March 15, inclusive of every year, in that portion of the Visayan Sea and adjoining waters enclosed by the north coast of Panay Island and the northern coast of Negros Island and also by straight lines connecting the following points: from the mouth of Davao River in Northwestern Negros to point at the southeastern tip of Bantayan Island; thence to Cuto Island; thence to Pulanduiz Point in the southweestern tip of Masbate; thence; southward to Balacaue Point in northwestern Panay; and thence a straight line from the mouth of Talisay River in eastern Panay eastward to Toronton Point in northwestern Negros."

2. This Administrative Order shall take effect on November 4, 1946.
