**Remarks/Market Observations:**

**The following observations were gathered from market personnel:**

- At Navotas Fish Port, minimal but still sufficient volumes of fresh marine commodities were noted this week. This might be due to the bad weather condition brought by the Southwest monsoon, Intertropical convergence Zone (ITCZ) and Typhoons. Despite the unfavorable weather condition this week, the prevailing wholesale price of medium sized local-fresh galunggong was lower at Php138.00 - Php168.00 /kg as compared last week.
- Meanwhile, only male variant of imported-frozen galunggong was recorded this week at the Navotas Fish Port price at Php120.00 & 130.00/kg.
- For medium sized bangus prevailing retail price of medium sized Bangus was noted to be in steady level, price at Php120.00 & 140.00/kg. Among the major sources are Pangasinan, Bulacan and Batangas.
- There continuous to have sufficient availability of supplies for medium sized tilapia this week at the Fish port. Relatively, prevailing price was recorded this week at Php90.00 & 95.00/kg source majority from Batangas.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
  - Bangus - Pangasinan, Bulacan
  - Tilapia - Batangas
  - Imported galunggong - China
- Precautionary measures (e.g., wearing of face mask and face shields as well as white boots and shirts, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection) are continuously implemented by the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) at Navotas Fish Port Complex to safeguard vendors and buyers against COVID-19.
