The following observations were gathered from market personnel:
Remarks/Market Observations:

- Adequate volumes of fresh marine commodities (i.e., tambakol, gulyasan, galunggong, balsa, tulingan, dalagang bukid, turay, and pusit) were unloaded at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) in the early part of the week. Supplies then decreased on the latter part of the week due to the effects of Tropical Depression "Lannie" and Severe Tropical Storm "Maring" plus the lean fishing season for fresh marine commodities.
- Local-fresh galunggong continue to be limited at the Navotas Fish Port this week. Higher actual wholesale price for local-fresh galunggong (*Decapterus macrosoma*) was recorded this week at Php153.00-180.00/kg. Galunggong "Balsa" (*Decapterus macarellus*) was available this week.
- Supply for Imported-frozen galunggong "lalaki" continue to be available at the Navotas Fish Port this week due to the limited supplies of its local-fresh variant. Imported-frozen galunggong "Babae" was available this week.
- No changes were observed at the prevailing wholesale prices of aquaculture commodities, like Bangus and Tilapia as supplies remained stable and sufficient at Navotas Fish Port.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Pangasinan, Laguna
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local galunggong- Northern Palawan
 - Imported galunggong - China
- Market administrators of Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) at Navotas Fish Port Complex continue to implement and observe precautionary safety measures against COVID-19 in accordance with the Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ) protocols to ensure that vendors and consumers protected against the virus. Among these measures are mandatory wearing of face masks and face shields, as well as white boots and shirts, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection.
