Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- At Navotas Fish Port, minimal but still sufficient volumes of fresh marine commodities were noted this week. This might be due to the bad weather condition brought by the trough of Typhoon "Mindulle" that affects the eastern section of Southern Luzon and Visayas. More specifically, the actual wholesale price recorded for medium sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki was at Php155.00 - 180.00/kg, source from Northern Palawan.
- Meanwhile, only male variant of imported-frozen galunggong was recorded this week at the Navotas Fish Port price at Php130.00/kg.
- For medium sized Bangus higher prevailing retail price was recorded this week due to limited availability of bangus from Bulacan.
- There continues to have sufficient availability of supplies for medium sized tilapia this week at the Fish port. Relatively, the prevailing wholesale price was sustained at Php95.00/kg source majority from Batangas.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Imported galunggong - China
- Precautionary measures (e.g., wearing of face mask and face shields as well as white boots and shirts, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection) are continuously implemented by the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) at Navotas Fish Port Complex to safeguard vendors and buyers against COVID-19.
