Remarks/Market Observations:	<p>The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors this week:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Generally, limited volumes of fresh marine commodities, particularly local-fresh galunggong, was observed at the monitored retail markets this week. This may be attributed to the bad weather condition brought by Typhoon "Mindulle" that affects eastern section of Southern Luzon and Visayas and the start of lean season for fresh marine commodities. Other local variants like "balsa" <i>Decapterus macarellus</i> and "burot" <i>Decapterus kurroides</i> were also not available at the retail markets this week. Imported-frozen Galunggong continue to be available at the monitored retail markets as supplies of local-fresh galunggong remain limited this week. Vendors sell imported-frozen galunggong as a substitute commodity for local-fresh galunggong. Most of the supplies for Alumahan are still large-size mainly sourced from Lucena, Quezon. Only minimal volume of supply was available for medium-sized Alumahan. No changes were reported for the prevailing retail prices of aquaculture commodities, particularly Bangus and Tilapia, as supplies remained stable and sufficient at the monitored retail markets this week. Top fishery commodities in the seventeen (17) monitored retail markets are sourced mainly from the following areas: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga Local Galunggong - Palawan, Lucena, Quezon Alumahan - Malabon Fish Port (Lucena, Quezon) "Matumal ang bentahan" continued to be apparent at the monitored retail markets this week. This may be attributed to the minimal demand for fishery commodities due to the low influx of buyers at the retail markets. Relative to this, most vendors do the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Sell lower volumes or limited varieties of fishery commodities to ensure that all supplies are sold out by the end of the day; and Open their fish stall on an alternate-day schedule or only during weekends where there is higher influx of people. In view of the escalating COVID-19 cases and implementation of Enhance Community Quarantine (ECQ) in Metro Manila, physical price monitoring activity in the eleven (11) monitored retail markets are temporarily suspended beginning 20 August 2021 (Friday) until further notice. Relative to this, daily price data and market observation are gathered via phone calls covering Top 4 Fishery commodities (i.e., bangus, tilapia, alumahan, local-fresh and imported-frozen galunggong). Market administrators continue to implement various precautionary safety measures against COVID-19 in accordance with the Modified General Community Quarantine (i.e., mandatory wearing of face masks and face shields, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection) to safeguard consumers and vendors against the virus. <p>General Observations:</p> <p>Fluctuation in the prices of the top fifteen (15) and other commodities is influenced by a number of factors such as the commodity's size, quality, source area, as well as the weather condition and other natural phenomena.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <i>Portunus pelagicus</i> or Alimasag - Large (Php350/kg - Php550/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php350.00/kg was recorded in Malabon Market where the available supplies were directly sourced from Fish Ports, hence, lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php550.00/kg was noted at Guadalupe Market where available supplies were sourced in primary markets which resulted to a higher price. <i>Scomberomorus commerson</i> or <i>Tangigue</i> (Php400- Php500/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php400.00/kg was recorded at Marikina and Pasig Markets where the available supplies were in small size which resulted to a lower price. Highest prevailing price at Php500.00/kg was noted at Mandaluyong and Guadalupe Markets where supplies were in large size which resulted to a higher price. <i>Acanthurus sp.</i> or <i>Labahita</i> (Php200- Php360/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php200.00/kg was recorded in Caloocan Market where the available supplies were directly sourced from Fish Ports, hence, lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php360.00/kg was noted at Guadalupe Market where available supplies were sourced in primary markets which resulted to a higher price. <i>Sphyræna sp.</i> or Torsilyo (Php200- Php300/kg) - Both the lowest and the highest price were recorded at Guadalupe Market. The difference in the price may be attributed to the size of the commodity. <i>Salmon salar</i> or Salmon - Head (Php140- Php300/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php150.00/kg was recorded in Malabon Market where the available supplies were directly sourced from Fish Ports, hence, lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php300.00/kg was noted at Marikina Market where available supplies were sourced in primary markets which resulted to a higher price. <i>Salmon salar</i> or Salmon - Meat (Php500- Php700/kg) - Both the lowest and the highest price were recorded at Guadalupe Market. The difference in the price may be attributed to the size of the commodity. <i>Sillago sihama</i> or Asohos (Php240- Php360/kg) - Both the lowest and the highest price were recorded at Guadalupe Market. The difference in the price may be attributed to the size of the commodity.
