Remarks/Market Observations	<p>The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of August:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Generally, minimal volumes of fresh marine commodities were noted this month due to the bad weather condition brought about by the following: Typhoon Jolina, trough of Typhoon Mindulle, Southwest Monsoon, and Intertropical Convergence Zone. Relative on this, higher prevailing prices of Php200.00 & 240.00/kg was recorded for medium sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki this Month. Meanwhile, limited availability of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki was still observed among the monitored retail markets this month, as supply of its local-fresh variant remained sufficient to cater the demand of the buying public. Still, majority of the available supply for alumahan was observed to be in large sizes this month. On the other hand, prevailing price for medium size of the commodity remain at Php300.00/kg among the monitored retail markets. For medium sized bangus lower prevailing prices of Php130.00 & 160.00/kg were recorded this month, which might be due to the ample availability of the commodity among the monitored retail markets. Consequently, sustained prevailing of Php120.00/kg was still recorded for medium-sized tilapia this month due to stable supply and demand in the monitored retail markets. Top fishery commodities in the sixteen (18) monitored retail markets are sourced mainly from the following areas: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan Tilapia - Batangas Local Galunggong - Navotas Fish Port (Palawan) & Lucena, Quezon Imported Galunggong - Navotas Alumahan - Malabon Fish Port Fluctuations in the prices of the top fifteen (15) and other commodities are influenced by a number of factors such as the commodity's size, quality, volume of supply, source area, as well as the weather condition and other natural phenomena. <i>Mene maculata</i> or Chabeta (Php200 - Php320/kg) -lowest prevailing price of Php200.00/kg was recorded at Guadalupe market on Week 2 and Ugong Valenzuela market on Week 3 where supply are noted to be in smaller sizes as compared to the highest recorded prevailing price of Php320.00/kg observed in Mandaluyong (week 2) and Guadalupe (week 1), which supplies are noted to be larger in sizes. In view of the escalating COVID-19 cases and implementation of Enhance Community Quarantine (ECQ) in Metro Manila, physical price monitoring activity in the ten (10) monitored retail markets are temporarily suspended beginning 20 August 2021 (Friday) until further notice. Relative to this, daily price data and market observation are gathered via phone calls covering Top 4 Fishery commodities (i.e., bangus, tilapia, alumahan, local-fresh and imported-frozen galunggong). Market administrators continue to implement and observe precautionary safety measures against COVID-19 in accordance with the Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ) protocols to ensure that vendors and consumers protected against the virus. Among these measures are wearing of facemasks and face shields, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection, and others.
