**Remarks/Market Observations:**

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of September:

- Generally, limited volumes of fresh marine commodities were observed at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this month. This may be attributed to the bad weather condition brought by the following: Typhoon "Jolina", Southwest Monsoon or "habagat", Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ)/ Easterlies, and trough of Typhoon "Mindulle". More specifically, for medium-sized Local-fresh Galunggong Lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*), the prices recorded were noted to be at a wide price range of Php130.00 - 180.00/kg this month due to variations in source areas of unloaded supplies.
- Imported-frozen Galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) continues to have available supply at the Navotas Fish Port with a monthly prevailing price of Php130.00/kg, while female variant of the said commodity (*Decapterus russelli*) was unavailable in the entire month.
- Meanwhile, wholesale prices for Bangus and Tilapia remained stable due to its steady supply and demand. Most supplies of Bangus from Pangasinan were reportedly bigger in size at 2-3 pcs/kg.
- Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas:
  - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
  - Tilapia - Batangas
  - local-fresh galunggong - Northern Palawan
  - Imported-frozen Galunggong - China
- As the COVID-19 pandemic remain in place, the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) continues to ensure the implementation of precautionary safety measures (eg., wearing of face masks and face shields as well as white shirt and white boots; and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection) to avoid further spread of the virus at Navotas Fish Port.
