**Remarks/Market Observations:**

**The following observations were gathered from market personnel:**

- Minimal volumes of fresh marine commodities were unloaded at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. This may be attributed to the following:
  - Onset of lean fishing season for marine commodities;
  - Cold weather condition;
  - Occurrence of fullmoon on 20 October.
- The supply for local-fresh Galunggong (*Decapterus macrosoma*) continues to be limited at the Fish Port. This resulted to a higher actual wholesale price at Php163.00/kg - Php190.00/kg this week. Other local galunggong like Galunggong "balsa" (*Decapterus macarellus*) and Galunggong "baba" (*Decapterus russelli*) were also available.
- Supplies of Imported-frozen Galunggong remain available at Navotas Fish Port due to the limited supply of Local-fresh Galunggong. More boxes of supply were observed this week as lower supplies of local were recorded.
- The prevailing wholesale price of Bangus was sustained at Php140.00/kg this week, this might be due to sufficient supply at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale). Meanwhile, the prevailing wholesale price of medium-sized Tilapia increased from Php90.00 & Php95.00 /kg last week to Php95.00 & Php100.00 /kg this week. The price increment may have been attributed to the bigger size of unloaded supplies from 4-6pcs/kg to 3-4pcs/kg this week.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
  - Bangus - Pangasinan, Laguna
  - Tilapia - Batangas
  - Local galunggong- Northern Palawan
  - Imported galunggong - China, Vietnam
- Market administrators of Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) at Navotas Fish Port Complex continue to implement and observe precautionary safety measures against COVID-19 in accordance with the General Community Quarantine -Alert level 3 (GCQ) protocols to ensure that vendors and consumers protected against the virus. Among these measures are mandatory wearing of face masks and face shields, as well as white boots and shirts, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection.
