**Remarks/Market Observations:**

**The following observations were gathered from market personnel:**

- At Navotas Fish Port (wholesale), minimal but sufficient volumes of fresh marine commodities were unloaded at the fish port this week. Among the fishery commodities recorded were tambakol, gulyasan, tulingan, galunggong, balsa, lapad, pusit, hasa-hasa, chabeta, espada, burot, and others. For local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*), only one (1) broker unloaded medium-sized of the commodity on October 25, 2021 with a wholesale price of Php215.00/kg and Php213.00/kg on October 27, 2021 both were sourced from Northern Palawan.
- In connection to the limited availability of its local-fresh variant, supplies for imported-frozen galunggong lalaki was present at the Fish Port with a prevailing wholesale price of Php128.00 & Php132.00 /kg (male variant) and Php85.00 & 87.00/kg (female variant) this week.
- The prevailing wholesale price of bangus was sustained at Php140.00/kg this week, as supplies of the commodity remained sufficient to cater the demand of the buying public. On the other hand, the prevailing wholesale price of tilapia decreased this week from Php95.00 & Php100.00 /kg to Php90.00 & Php95.00 /kg this week. The price decrement may have been attributed to the quality (in terms of size) of the commodity from 3-4pcs/kg last week to 4-6/kg this week.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
  - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
  - Tilapia - Batangas
  - Local-fresh galunggong - Northern Palawan
  - Imported galunggong - China & Vietnam
- Precautionary measures (e.g., wearing of face mask and face shields as well as white boots and shirts, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection) are continuously implemented by the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) at Navotas Fish Port Complex to safeguard vendors and buyers against COVID-19.
