Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Limited but sufficient volumes of fresh marine commodities were unloaded at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. Other fishery commodities, available were dalagang bukid, burot, hipon, tunsoy, salinyase, lapad, tambakol, gulyasan, tamban, galunggong, pusit, bisugo, betilya, chabeta, balsa, lapad and others. For local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*), only two (2) brokers unloaded medium-sized of the commodity on November 2, 2021 with a wholesale price of Php153.00/kg and Php145.00/kg on November 5, 2021 both were sourced from Palawan.
- Ample volumes of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) continued to be available at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. In fact, nineteen (19) brokers on November 2, 2021 and fifteen (15) brokers on November 5, 2021 unloaded the commodity. Additionally, supplies of imported-frozen galunggong babae (*Decapterus ruselli*) was also observed this week with a prevailing retail price of Php87.00/kg. Major sourced areas of the commodities were Vietnam and China.
- Meanwhile, supplies of medium sized alumahan resumed at the Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) on November 2, 2021 with actual price of Php133.00/kg, derived from Northern Palawan.
- Aquaculture commodities especially bangus and tilapia continues to have ample availability at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. More specifically, the prevailing wholesale price recorded for medium-sized of the commodity were at Php120.00 & 140.00/kg (bangus) and Php90.00/kg (tilapia).
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local-fresh galunggong - Palawan
 - Imported galunggong - China & Vietnam
- Precautionary measures (e.g., wearing of face mask and face shields as well as white boots and shirts, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection) are continuously implemented by the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) at Navotas Fish Port Complex to safeguard vendors and buyers against COVID-19.
