Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of May:

- Minimal supplies of local-fresh galunggong were observed at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this month due to the following:
 - Lean fishing season for fresh marine commodities;
 - Hampered fishing operations brought by three (3) tropical cyclones this month;
 - Cold weather condition wherein fishes tend to go to the bottom of the ocean making them harder to catch.
 The actual wholesale price for local-fresh galunggong this month is at Php110-215.00/kg. Meanwhile, wholesale price of local-fresh galunggong is at an increasing trend this month as lesser supplies were observed amidst the nearing of Closed Fishing Season on 1 November 2021. There are also other local variant like Balsa (*Decapterus macarellus*), Babae (*Decapterus russelli*), and Burot (*Decapterus kurroides*) observed at the said Fish Port.
- Abundant supplies for imported-frozen galunggong "lalaki" and "babae" were available at Navotas Fish Port throughout the whole month due to the low supply of local-fresh galunggong. The demand for imported-frozen galunggong increased as it is considered a substitute commodity for its local variant.
- The wholesale prices for aquaculture commodities like Bangus and Tilapia have remained stable due to the sufficient supplies at Navotas Fish Port. Prices may vary depending on the size, volume and quality of the commodity.
- Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local-fresh Galunggong - Northern Palawan
 - Imported-frozen Galunggong - China
- Market administrators of Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) at Navotas Fish Port Complex continue to implement and observe precautionary safety measures against COVID-19 in accordance with the Alert-3 quarantine protocols to ensure that vendors and consumers protected against the virus. Among these measures are mandatory wearing of face masks and face shields, as well as white boots and shirts, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection.
