Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- At Navotas Fish Port (wholesale), minimal volumes of fresh marine commodities were unloaded this week. These included gulyasan, balsa, galunggong babae, tambakol, tulingan, chabeta, espada, labahita, pusit, lumut, tamban, and others. For local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*), no medium-sized commodity was unloaded at the fish port. This could possibly be due to the closed fishing season for round scads (*Decapterus spp.*) in North-Eastern Palawan where it is chiefly sourced as well as the lean fishing season for fresh marine commodities. On the other hand, sufficient volumes of local-fresh variants (i.e., balsa, burot,) were unloaded at the port this week sourcing from Quezon Province, Batangas and Zambales.
- There continues to have ample availability of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. In fact, twenty one (21) brokers on November 16, 2021 and eleven (11) brokers on November 19, 2021 unloaded the commodity. However, supplies of imported-frozen galunggong babae (*Decapterus ruselli*) was only observed on November 16, 2021 with a prevailing retail price of Php84.00/kg. Major sourced areas of the commodities were Vietnam and China.
- For alumahan, limited volumes of medium-sized commodity were unloaded at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week, wherein only one (1) broker were recorded on November 16, 2021, with a wholesale price of Php150.00/kg sourced from Masbate.
- Meanwhile, ample availability of aquaculture commodities especially bangus and tilapia were still observed at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. More specifically, the prevailing wholesale price recorded for medium-sized of the commodity were at Php150.00/kg (bangus) and Php90.00 & 95.00/kg (tilapia).
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local-fresh galunggong -NA
 - Imported galunggong - China & Vietnam
 - Alumahan- Masbate
- In accordance with the General Community Quarantine (GCQ)- Alert level II, precautionary measures (e.g., wearing of face mask as well as white boots and shirts, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection) are continuously implemented by the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) at Navotas Fish Port Complex to safeguard vendors and buyers against COVID-19.
