Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Minimal volumes of fresh marine commodities were still observed at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. These included tambakol, gulyasan, burot, tunsoy, balsa, turay, dalagang bukid, lapad bilog, pusit, tamban, bisugo and others. For medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*), no unloadings of the commodity were noted this week. On the other hand, limited volume of small sized of the commodity was observed at the fish port on December 14, 2021 price at Php140.00/kg source from Balabac Strait. This could be caused by the inclement weather condition brought about by Typhoon Odette (International Name: "Rai") which largely affected Visayas and MIMAROPA region. Additionally, the influence of ongoing implementation of Closed Fishing Season for round scads (*Decapterus spp.*) in North-eastern Palawan where it is mainly derived.
- Meanwhile, ample volumes of imported-frozen galunggong continuously observed at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week, which might be due to the limited availability of the local-fresh variant.
- For medium sized alumahan only one (1) broker unloaded the commodity on December 14, 2021 with a prevailing wholesale price of Php200.00/kg source from Masbate.
- On the other hand, aquaculture commodities such as bangus and tilapia were continuously observed to have sufficient availability at the Fish Port this week at Php110.00/kg and Php90.00/kg & Php95.00/kg respectively.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local-fresh galunggong - NA
 - Imported galunggong - China & Vietnam
 - Alumahan- NA
- In accordance with the General Community Quarantine (GCQ)- Alert level II, precautionary measures (e.g., wearing of face mask as well as white boots and shirts, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection) are continuously implemented by the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) at Navotas Fish Port Complex to safeguard vendors and buyers against COVID-19.
