Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of May:

- The implementation of Closed Fishing Season (CFS) for local-fresh galunggong and alumahan at Northeastern Palawan and Visayan Sea resulted to a limited supplies unloaded at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) throughout this month. Also the cold weather condition contributed to the minimal supplies of fresh marine commodities at the fish ports.
The actual wholesale price for local-fresh galunggong this month is at Php145-238.00/kg. The actual prices of Local-fresh Galunggong is at an increasing trend due to lesser supply caused by the CFS on 1 Nov 2021. There are also other local variant like Balsa (*Decapterus macarellus*), Babae (*Decapterus russelli*), and Burot (*Decapterus kurroides*) observed at the said Fish Port.
- The supply of imported-frozen galunggong "lalaki" and "babae" at Navotas Fish Port remained abundant throughout the whole month. The demand for imported-frozen galunggong increased as it is considered a substitute commodity for the local variant.
- There is a slight increased in the prevailing wholesale price of Bangus compared from previous months. According to wholesalers, most of the supplies unloaded are medium-large-size (2-3pcs). This may be attributed to nearing of Christmas Holiday wherein some suppliers delay their time of harvest to achieved the commodity's marketable size (good size). The prevailing price of Tilapia had no changes due to the steady demand and supply at the markets.
- Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local-fresh Galunggong - Northern Palawan
 - Imported-frozen Galunggong - China
- Market administrators of Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) at Navotas Fish Port Complex continue to implement and observe precautionary safety measures against COVID-19 in accordance with the Alert-2 quarantine protocols to ensure that vendors and consumers protected against the virus. Among these measures are mandatory wearing of face masks and face shields, as well as white boots and shirts, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection.
