Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Minimal volumes of fresh marine commodities were unloaded at the Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. Among the fishery commodities recorded were tambakol, gulyasan, bilog, lapad, pusit, lumut, balsa, espada and others. For medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macorosoma*), no unloadings of the commodity were recorded this week. This could possibly be due to the following reasons:
 - Cold weather condition brought by the shearline or tail end of frontal system affecting Southern Luzon and Visayas;
 - Northeast Monsoon or "Amihan" affecting rest of Luzon;
 - Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Southern Mindanao; and
 - Closed Fishing season for scads (*Decapterus spp.*) in North-Eastern Palawan where it is mainly derived.
- Meanwhile, ample volumes of imported-frozen galunggong were continuously observed at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. In fact, ten (10) brokers unloaded imported-frozen galunggong lalaki at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) on 26 December 2021 at Php125.00/kg.
- For medium sized alumahan only one (1) broker unloaded the commodity on December 26, 2021 with a recorded actual wholesale price of Php200.00/kg source from Masbate.
- In contrary, sufficient volumes of unloading were noted for aquaculture commodities (bangus and tilapia) this week. On the other hand, majority of the supply noted for bangus are large sizes source from Pangasinan and Bulacan. Meanwhile, unloaded supply of tilapia are still in mixed sizes source majorly from Batangas.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - a. Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - b. Tilapia - Batangas
 - c. Local-fresh galunggong -NA
 - d. Imported galunggong - China & Vietnam
 - e. Alumahan- Masbate
- In accordance with the General Community Quarantine (GCQ)- Alert level III, precautionary measures (e.g., wearing of face mask as well as white boots and shirts, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection) are continuously implemented by the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) at Navotas Fish Port Complex to safeguard vendors and buyers against COVID-19.
