Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- At Navotas Fish Port (wholesale), minimal quantity of fresh marine commodities were unloaded this week. Commodities recorded were tambakol, gulyasan, tulingan, balsa, burot, dalagang bukid, lapad, espada, pusit, tamban, betilya, and others.
- For local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosom*), no medium-sized commodity was unloaded at the fish port throughout the whole week. This could still be due to the ongoing implementation of closed fishing season at Northeastern Palawan (*Decapterus spp.*) where it is mainly sourced and cold weather condition caused by the Northeast monsoon affecting Luzon and Visayas.
- Supplies of imported-frozen galunggong continue to be abundant at Navotas Fish Port due to the unavailability of its local-fresh variant.
- The prevailing wholesale price of bangus sourced from Pangasinan and Bulacan had a small increment as most of the unloaded supplies were large sized (2-3pcs).
- The prevailing wholesale price of tilapia remained stable due to the sufficient supply at the fish ports.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local galunggong- NA
 - Imported galunggong - China, Vietnam
 - Alumahan - NA
- Market administrators continue to strictly implement precautionary safety measures in the monitored markets to ensure the consumers and vendors safety and avoid the further spread of highly infectious COVID-19 OMICRON variant in accordance with the General Community Quarantine- Alert Level 3 guidelines. Among these measures are the mandatory wearing of face masks, social distancing and regular schedule of cleaning and disinfection in the markets, and among others.
