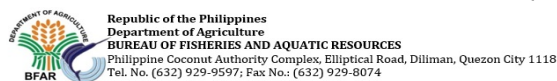

Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of August:

- Supply of fresh marine commodity, particularly Local-fresh Galunggong, unloaded at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) remained sufficient in the 1st-3rd week of this month. Low volume of supply was observed during the 4th to 5th week of the month due to the occurrence of Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ)/ Easterlies, and fullmoon last August 22, 2021. The actual price for Local-fresh Galunggong this month is at Php120-178.00/kg. There were also other local variant like Balsa (*Decapterus macarellus*), Babae (*Decapterus russelli*), and Burot (*Decapterus kurroides*) observed at the said Fish Port.
- Supplies of imported-frozen Galunggong "lalaki" and "babae" were still available at Navotas Fish Port throughout the whole month despite the sufficient and ample supply of local-fresh galunggong. The demand for imported-frozen galunggong increased as it is considered a substitute commodity for its local variant.
- Meanwhile, the wholesale prices for aquaculture commodities like Bangus and Tilapia remained stable due to the sufficient supplies at Navotas Fish Port this month. Prices of the commodity differ depending on the source, quality and volume unloaded.
- Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Laguna, Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local-fresh galunggong - Northern Palawan
 - Imported-frozen Galunggong - China
- Market administrators of Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) at Navotas Fish Port Complex continue to implement and observe precautionary safety measures against COVID-19 in accordance with the Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ) protocols to ensure that vendors and consumers protected against the virus. Among these measures are mandatory wearing of face masks and face shields, as well as white boots and shirts, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection.
