Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Sufficient volumes of fresh marine commodities were observed at the Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. More specifically for galunggong variants (i.e., balsa, burot and babae), ample volumes of the commodities were recorded last Feb 4, 2022. For local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*), two (2) brokers unloaded the small to medium-sized commodity with 2,458 banyeras (volume) at wholesale price of Php158.00/kg and Php170.00/kg sourced from Balabac Strait Palawan. In addition, the Closed Fishing Season (CFS) for galunggong (*Decapterus* spp.) in North-Eastern Palawan was just lifted on February 1, 2022 (Tuesday).
- Limited supplies were still recorded for alumahan due to the implementation of closed fishing season at Visayan Sea which is a major fishing area for mackerels, sardines and herrings.
- Sufficient volume of supplies were still observed for imported-frozen galunggong at Navotas Fish Port despite the availability of local-fresh galunggong this week.
- There were no changes in the prevailing wholesale prices of bangus and tilapia due to the sufficient supplies unloaded at the Navotas Fish Ports.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local galunggong- Balabac Strait, Palawan
 - Imported galunggong - China, Vietnam
 - Alumahan - Masbate, Zamboanga
- Market administrators continue to strictly implement precautionary safety measures in the monitored markets to ensure the consumers and vendors safety and avoid the further spread of highly infectious COVID-19 OMICRON variant in accordance with the General Community Quarantine- Alert Level 3 guidelines. Among these measures are the mandatory wearing of face masks, social distancing and regular schedule of cleaning and disinfection in the markets, and among others.
