Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Sufficient volumes of fresh marine commodities were observed at the Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. Fishery commodities recorded were gulyasan, tambakol, dalagang bukid, lapad, hipon, pusit, saliayase, tamban, burot, galunggong, balsa, turay, pompano, and others.
- Supplies of local-fresh galunggong unloaded at the Fish Port increased this week. Supplies are expected to increase more following the lifting of Closed Fishing Season in Northeastern Palawan last Feb 1. There are other local galunggong variants available like balsa, babae, and burot.
- Imported-frozen galunggong remain available at the Fish Port this week despite the sufficient supply of local galunggong.
- Same prevailing wholesale prices were recorded for bangus and tilapia this week due to the stable demand and sufficient supply unloaded at the Fish Port.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local galunggong- Cuyo Pass, Palawan, Quezon
 - Imported galunggong - China, Vietnam
 - Alumahan - NA
- Market administrators continue to strictly implement precautionary safety measures in the monitored markets to ensure the consumers and vendors safety and avoid the further spread of highly infectious COVID-19 OMICRON variant in accordance with the General Community Quarantine- Alert Level 1 guidelines. Among these measures are the mandatory wearing of face masks, social distancing and regular schedule of cleaning and disinfection in the markets, and among others.
