Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Sufficient volumes of fresh marine commodities were observed at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. Commodities recorded were dalagang bukid, gulyasan, tamban, burot, matambaka, lapad, pusit, lumot, tambakol, chabeta, espada, and others.
- Abundant supply of local-fresh galunggong were unloaded at the Navotas Fish Port this week. This resulted to a small decreased in the prevailing wholesale price. More and more supplies are being unloaded following the liftinf of closed fishing season last Feb 1. There are other local galunggong variants available like balsa, babae, and burot.
- Despite the available supply of local-fresh galunggong at the Fish Port, supplies of imported-frozen galunggong remained available. There are still demand for imported galunggong due to its cheaper price making it easier to sell.
- The prevailing wholesale price of bangus and tilapia remained the same compared last week due to the sufficient supply and stable demand at the Fish Port. There is a slight decreased in the wholesale price of Bangus last Feb 25, as supplies unloaded were small to medium size (3-5pcs).
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Pangasinan, Bulacan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local galunggong- Northern Palawan
 - Imported galunggong - China, Vietnam
 - Alumahan - Masbate
- Market administrators continue to strictly implement precautionary safety measures in the monitored markets to ensure the consumers and vendors safety and avoid the further spread of highly infectious COVID-19 OMICRON variant in accordance with the General Community Quarantine- Alert Level 1 guidelines. Among these measures are the mandatory wearing of face masks, social distancing and regular schedule of cleaning and disinfection in the markets, and among others.
